Maths Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs)

Across school we have started a new approach to learning key facts in Maths. Each half term your child will bring home a sheet with a list of key instant recall facts (KIRFS) that they need to learn. Pupils will be tested through the half term on these facts. Please look at them carefully with your child and spend some time helping them learn them. There are '**Top Tips**' on the bottom of the page to help you find ways to help your child; little and often is usually the most effective way. We often find in school that the children's progress in more complex maths is hampered by them not having simple instant recall facts; all of the number facts that we are asking them to learn are essential in their work in school.

Please also continue to practise times tables facts with your child. We have restarted the Times tables challenge this week as we know that they are such a key skill.

Thank you for your help and support with this.

School meals are free for YR/Y1 & Y2 and cost £2.10 per day for other year groups. Meals are freshly cooked each day in our kitchen by Mrs



Johnson. Meals must be taken as a full week. With the exception of promotional meals (such as Christmas Dinner) we do not have the capacity to offer 'one off meals' For food ordering purposes **the school office** requires one week's notice to change to/from school meals.

REMINDERS

Attendance

We ask that children are **not** taken out of school for routine appointments (such as dental/medical/optician). Proof of any appointments during the school day is always required. If you fail to provide this, your child's absence may be recorded as unauthorised which could lead to referral to the Area Prevention Service. If your child is absent, you should notify school by phone before 9.30 am.

School Uniform

We pride ourselves on the appearance of our school and this includes school uniform. There is plenty of choice within our uniform code for children to express their individuality—please note that we do not encourage children to wear brightly coloured trainers and shoes with flashing lights which can be a great distraction in school!

Lunch boxes

We have clearly labelled trolleys to keep lunch boxes on for each class. Packed lunches are stored during the morning in a cool place and children are asked not to keep their lunch in the cloakroom where there are heating pipes. We therefore ask that when your child brings a lunchbox to school, it is small enough to fit on the trolleys. The trolleys take standard size children's lunchboxes but are not built to store large bags.

PE bags and kit

Every child has a named school PE bag which should be brought to school every Monday and taken home for washing every Friday. Please ensure PE kit is labelled with your child's name. Children from Y1-Y6 need black shorts, white T shirt and pumps/trainers. You might like to send them with dark coloured jogging bottoms and a school purple sports hoodie when the weather gets colder. Your child will be able to tell you whether they are planning inside or outside PE this term. We do not have the space to store large unwieldy bags and ask that children **do not bring them into school**—school book bags can be purchased for home learning/reading books. Jewellery including hooped earrings are not permitted. Pierced earrings should be removed for PE and swimming.
