

## We currently have a vacancy for a Parent Governor in our School.

Our governors are friendly, committed and hard-working, from a wide range of backgrounds. They are focussed on making our school the best place for our children to grow and learn. You can find out more about what our governors do by visiting the governor page of our school website.



School governors meet as a full board four times a year— three of these meetings are during the day (usually starting at 12.30pm) and one is an evening meeting. Governors also serve on one of the two governors' groups which meet once every half term.

**School Business Group - Pupil Outcome Group.** The Pupil Outcome Group meets in the afternoon and the School Business Group meets at 5.30pm.

**Eligibility** Parent governors are elected by other parents at the school. Any parent, or carer, of a registered pupil at the school at the time of election is eligible to stand for election as a parent governor. Parent governors may continue to hold office until the end of their term of office even if their child leaves the school.

Section 576 of the Education Act 1996 defines "parent" to include:

- All natural parents, whether they are married or not; and
- Any person who, although not a natural parent, has parental responsibility for a child or young person; and
- Any person who, although not a natural parent, has care of a child or young person.

**Disqualifications** The disqualification criteria in the relevant Regulations apply and these are set out on the form "Self Declaration". Prospective governors are required, as part of the nomination procedure, to complete a self-declaration to confirm that they are eligible to become a school governor. An enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service certificate check will be required for the successful candidate.

**Election** - if more than one nomination is received, a formal election will take place.

Term of Office; a parent elected or appointed as a Parent Governor shall hold office for a period of four years

These should be returned to school **no later than 12 noon on Friday 27 March 2020** when nominations close.

### Illness and School Absence

These are worrying times for everyone. Please support and protect our school family by not sending your child into school if they are unwell.

**Coronavirus Symptoms** Stay at home for 7 days if you have either: a high temperature and/or a new, continuous cough.

Should schools be told close, we will be delivering teaching through Google Classroom. Our children already use this in school. This week we have checked that all children have an account. The following information, including your child's login details, will shortly be sent home. The information below will also be posted on the school website. Please try these at home and let teacher know if you have problems accessing Google Classroom.

### How to access Google Classroom at home.

1. Open a web browser and go to [www.google.co.uk](http://www.google.co.uk).
2. In the top right hand corner of the screen you will see a link to Gmail. Click it.
3. Log in here to your school Gmail account.
4. Once you have logged in and you are in your inbox, you will notice the Google Apps link in the top right hand corner of the browser. This is the 9 dot logo that you use in school to access Google Classroom. Click on here and the link to Google classroom should appear.
5. Click on the Google classroom link. You should now see your year group's classroom. Click on it to enter.

**You must be logged into your school email account for Google Classroom to work.**

## On-line Bookings

We run a cashless school. We would like to simplify the process of payments in school. We currently use a range of on-line portals (website, ParentPay, Live Kitchen) which we would like to gradually streamline so that all payments will be processed through our school website — we think this will be much easier for everyone.

All parents will need to register for a school account through our school website to be able to use this facility.

### Extra-curricular Activity Clubs

We are currently trialling an online booking system for all extra-curricular activity clubs run by school staff. If you currently use our on-line booking system to book before and after school childcare places, you will be able to use your existing parent account. If not, you can register as a parent user by visiting <https://www.wherelernersgrow.co.uk/user/register>.

Once your account has been verified, you will need to add each child by clicking on the 'Add Child' tab under the 'My Children' heading. You can then select 'Extra Curricular Clubs' and follow the step-by-step instructions through to checkout.
