On-line Bookings

We run a cashless school.

We would like to simplify the process of payments in school. We currently use a range of on-line portals; website, ParentPay, Live Kitchen (School Grid) which we would like to gradually streamline so that all payments will be processed only through our school website – we think this will be much easier for everyone.

All parents will need to register for a school account through our school website to be able to use this facility.

Extra-curricular Activity Clubs

From next half term we will be trialling an online booking system for all extra-curricular activity clubs led by Mrs Howes.

If you currently use our on-line booking system to book before and after school childcare places, you will be able to use your existing parent account. If not, you can register as a parent user by visiting <https://www.wherelernersgrow.co.uk/user/register>.

Once your account has been verified, you will need to add each child by clicking on the 'Add Child' tab under the 'My Children' heading. You can then select 'Extra Curricular Clubs' and follow the step-by-step instructions through to checkout.

Next half term, Mrs Howes will be leading the following clubs.

Places will be available to book via the website from Wednesday 5th February; there are a limited number of places available per club and bookings will close when they are full to capacity.

Payment can be made via card, childcare vouchers or tax-free child care

Meanwhile school meals will continue to be ordered and paid for through Live Kitchen (School Grid). Places for Kanga Sports and Fencing Club will still be booked (on paper) and paid for directly with them. Any other miscellaneous payments (eg. trips, swimming and school uniform etc) must be paid through ParentPay. We'll let you know when we plan to move these over to school website bookings.
