We currently provide school meals through North Yorkshire County Catering. They are free for YR/Y1 & Y2 and cost £2.82 per day for other year groups. Meals are freshly cooked each day in our kitchen by NYCC Meals must be taken as a full week. With the exception of promotional meals (such as Christmas Dinner) we do not have the capacity to offer 'one off meals' For food ordering purposes **the school office** requires one week's notice to change to/from school meals.


