New School Meals Service Planned roll out—Monday 4th February

The Governors have previously written to you to let you know that they would be appointing a new school meals provider in order to offer increased choice and flexibility at a competitive price. We are excited to let you know that our new school meal provider is Dolce Schools Catering.

The benefits that Dolce offer are as follows

- An increased meal option choice
- An increased flexibility of booking (for example one off meals)
- An online booking system where Parents can choose their child's meal
- A direct payment system between parents and Dolce (bypassing the school office)
- A reduction in current cost per meal to parents (from £2.82 per meal to £2.30 per meal)
- A removal of the current need for the school budget to subsidise the cost of KS1 Meals (currently £2000 per term)

Even if your child does not currently take a school meal, we would recommend that you activate your 'Live Kitchen' account with Dolce and 'Live Kitchen Account' to allow you the flexibility of using the service as and when you need it.

Payments will be made by yourselves **DIRECT TO DOLCE** using your new Live Kitchen Account and can either be by Direct Debit or by Credit/Debit card.

From the point at which we move to Dolce (scheduled for Monday 4th February) we will NOT BE USING PARENTPAY FOR SCHOOL MEAL PAYMENTS

Your new 'Live Kitchen' account

Your email details will be submitted to Dolce on Monday 28th January using the email address you have either provided, or you're the one currently associated with your Parent Pay details. (you have already give us this)

This will enable Dolce to activate your 'Live Kitchen' account.

Dolce will begin their meal service on Monday 4th February.

Lunch Service is going to look a little different when our Dolce Restaurant opens. There will be less tables in the hall and classes will be called in together—allowing friends to sit together. The younger classes will be served first which means that children in key stage two will have an opportunity to play outside for a short while before going for their lunch. Things might be a little slow as we all work through the changes but we are confident that overall lunchtimes are set to become altogether more pleasant!

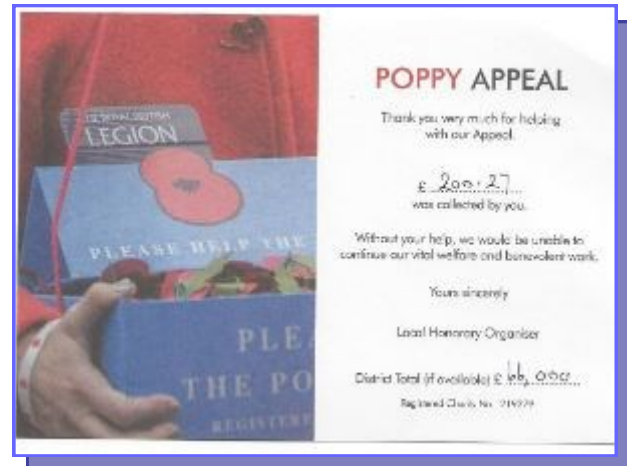
Parking on Private (unmade up) road outside school

May we please remind you that the unmade up road is **private land**—jointly owned by the residents and the school. **It should not be used at any time by parents for parking.**

If you are dropping off your children at breakfast club please park on Bridge Road to enable staff to park. Staff often have heavy bags to carry into school.

Driving onto and reversing out of the private road, onto the main road at the end of the day, puts children, parents and other drivers at in danger when they are coming out of school.

We know that parking is challenging at busy times but there are plenty of side streets to park on—it's really not worth the risks that some drivers are taking. We work closely with the police and traffic wardens and will pass on registration details which cause concern. We urge parents to do the same.

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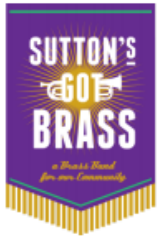
