School meals are free for YR/Y1 & Y2 and cost £2.10 per day for other year groups. Meals are freshly cooked each day in our kitchen by Mrs. Johnson. Meals must be taken as a full week. With the exception of promotional meals (such as Christmas Dinner) we do not have the capacity to offer 'one off meals' For food ordering purposes the school office requires one week's notice to change to/from school meals.



## The Big Build Update—week two

The old Y5 classroom has now been demolished—which makes the playground seem huge!

This week the rest of the debris will be removed and work on the foundations for the new classroom will begin. Mr Saye, the Project Manager, is very impressed with our children who he says are 'fantastic' - each playtime the contractors have a crowd of very interested observers!

As always our school family remains our primary concern.

Here's how you can help...

1. The front gate will be out of action during the works—part of the wall will be demolished (and then rebuilt) to accommodate access to the site. During the project you should use the gate adjacent to the park for all access into school.
2. Please make every attempt to walk to school if you can—you may need to park your car further away from school than you usually do.
3. Waiting space in the front playground will be very limited at the beginning and the end of the school day. It should be possible for all children to enter and exit the building through their usual door.
4. If you have any concerns regarding the site, please discuss them with Mrs Beetles.


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## Y5 & Y6 Performance


