


## Dragon!

## School Business Group

The Governors' School Business Group met this week.

On the agenda was budget monitoring and considering the end of year balance. We have managed the budget well to support children in school and have achieved a realistic carry forward as we move into a new financial year.

We reviewed the traded services we buy (such as insurances, HR, health and safety, legal services, cleaning and caretaking) in terms of whether they provide best value for our school. We briefly discussed the outstanding snagging issues on the Y5 and Y6 classroom build and one of our governors has agreed to collate a list of our outstanding 'snags' - most of these are minor—with the exception of the metal ramp which we think should be improved. We finalised plans for the redevelopment of the front playground to include two trim trails and a stage area—this is a jointly funded project between the Family Fundraisers and the School Budget. The work is scheduled to take place over the Easter break.

Finally, as always, we agreed the impact of the work of the group on the pupils' learning.


