Dear Parents/Carers,

The children are now starting to rehearse for our Nativity, 'The Shining Star of Bethlehem' which will be performed on **Tuesday 10th December** and **Wednesday 11th December** at **South Craven Baptist Church**. Both performances start at 2pm.

Each child has been given two tickets per performance. Space is restricted due to fire regulations but if you require more, please come and speak to a member of staff. Parents are very welcome to swap tickets for performances between themselves. Please note that for children who are able to sit on a parent's knee, no ticket is required. The tickets cost £1 each which will contribute towards the cost of props and costumes for the performance. Please make the appropriate payment on Parent Pay and return any unwanted tickets.

You will be aware that as part of our data collection procedure, parents and carers are asked to indicate if we are permitted to take photos / videos of their child for use in school or on the website. Please be advised that some parents in Reception have withdrawn their permission for this to take place and consequently, you will not be able to record or take photos during the nativity performances. Staff will take individual photographs of the children in their costumes which will be sent home. Please can we ask you to respect the wishes of those parents who have withdrawn their permission.

If your child was asked to bring in specific items of clothing for the performance, please ensure that they are sent into school in a named carrier bag as soon as possible, or by **Wednesday 4th December at the absolute latest**. Please check the letter your child brought home about specific clothes they may need to wear on the days of the performances.

If your child has a speaking part, please support them at home to learn their words so that they feel happy and confident on the day!
