#### **Times Tables**

As our year 4 parents will be aware, the Year 4 children will complete their times tables statutory check this June. We want to make sure that the children are fully prepared for what the Year 5 and Year 6 Mathematics curriculum throws at them. Knowing their times tables confidently really does have a huge impact on their confidence and success in upper key stage 2 and beyond. All the children across school are learning their times tables and have access to Times Tables Rock Stars at school and at home. We are requesting your support in encouraging the children to practice these as regularly as possible when at home. It doesn't take long to have a go and this regular practice will make a huge difference in the long run. If you are unsure of how to access this resource please get in touch with your child's class teacher.

### **Parking**

Unfortunately, we are having repeated complaints from our local residents about the parking around school and parents parking across residents' private driveways.
