With the exception of promotional meals (such as Christmas Dinner) we do not have the capacity to offer 'one off meals' For ordering purposes the school office requires one week's notice to change to/from school meals. **This is still the case even if your child has a free school meal in KS1.**

## Y6 Enthusiastic Scientists!

Last Friday, ten year six pupils went to Otley Street Nursery in Skipton to work with their pupils on some 'wow' science investigations with the theme of Pirates and Mermaids. This was part of a joint 'Enthuse' funded science project with several local primary and nursery schools.

Science based activities included chemical reactions between bicarbonate of soda and vinegar; chromatography (splitting colours); exploring the textures and fragrances of different plants and herbs, plus looking at the properties of materials and whether they float or not. Our pupils really enjoyed being scientists for the morning and explaining what was happening to the nursery pupils. Our visit was a huge success! Pupils were (as always when representing our school) absolutely fantastic: they were impeccably behaved; enthusiastic and engaged in the scientific activities; confident and well-mannered with the nursery pupils, parents and staff, and a joy to spend time with.

The nursery staff commented on how impressed they were with their conduct and the fact that they actually helped to tidy up after themselves! They really were pupils to be wholly proud of!


