

## Marking and Feedback



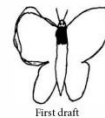
When your work is marked these are some of the things you might see.

- *sp* to show you got a spelling wrong. You will need to write the correct spelling out so that you can get it right in future.
- If you get an answer wrong in maths it will have a cross or a dot next to it.
- How well you have achieved the learning objective - it might be ticked or highlighted, or a stamp or comment will tell you.
- A cloud shows something you did well and a brick shows your next steps.
- Your teacher might write "verbal feedback" on your work to show that you have talked about your work with someone.
- A post it to remind you of something you keep forgetting. (e.g. capital letters.)

Pupils always use green pen for marking and improving.



Improvements are really important. Always check your work to see if there are some next steps for you to do. When your teacher gives you time to improve your work make sure you use it well.



## Presentation

- underline the date and title with a ruler and a pencil
