We introduced ourselves to each other and made sure that we all knew what the role of school councillors is. We made sure that our expectations of each other were reasonable. Our main job was to review the anti-bullying policy. We had a very constructive discussion about what we mean by bullying and the different kinds of bullying including

- Physical
- Attacking property
- Verbal
- Psychological
- Cyber

We agreed that bullying can be based on any of the factors detailed in the Policy.

We also agreed that bullying is repeated and deliberate. People who are bullied can be made to feel sad and/or worthless. Bullies may also suffer in the long run through losing friends and being punished. We looked at the things we should do if we are being bullied.

It was agreed that the anti-bullying policy could go to Governors to be approved. The worry box is to be opened again and monitored by Mrs Dwyer and Yr 6 pupils.

The other things we did.

- We contributed to the display that Mrs Dwyer is putting up in the Hall
- Mrs Dwyer is to give out consent forms to those members of Council who want to help at the Open Afternoon. (And collect them back in.)
