Where will we sleep?

Staff are available for the children in the evening should they be unsettled and require some support with being away from home.

Staff dormitories are clearly labelled so that children can find them easily.

Meals

- All children need to bring a packed lunch on the Monday.
- A cooked breakfast is served to start the day.
- Packed lunches are provided on full activity days with a choice of sandwich.
- A selection of home-cooked main courses plus desserts are offered at each evening meal.
- Home-made cakes/biscuits and hot drinks are available at supper time.
- Every effort is made to accommodate special dietary needs provided we are informed in advance of our visit. We can then inform the catering team. No child will go hungry!
- No sweets or snacks please! These are not permitted in dormitories.

Timetable

- Pupils usually rise at 7.15 a.m with breakfast to follow.
- The groups meet their Borwick Hall group teachers at 9 a.m. when they are briefed on the programmed activity for the day.
- Activities can be full or half day, on or off site.
- Groups return from activities in time to shower and relax before tea.
- The evening programme follows until supper, some of which is self led by Sutton CP staff and some activities are led by centre staff.

The day we go!

- Come into school at the usual time, line bags along the playground wall (by main gates).
- If wet, bring bags into the hall.
- Pupils register as usual in the classroom.
- Coach pick up at approx. 9.30am.
- Parents are welcome to wait and wave our children off.
- Make sure any travel sickness medication has been administered to your child before they come to school (plus extra to be given to Miss Ibbotson for the return journey – clearly labelled with name and dosage).
- All other medication should also be handed to Miss Ibbotson on arrival, clearly labelled with instructions on doses to administer etc.
- All money should be handed to Miss Dwyer on arrival in clearly labelled purses / envelopes. Children do not require any more than £5.

- The coach will leave Borwick Hall at 2pm to be back at school by the end of the school day.
- Any updates regarding return times/delays will be posted on the school Facebook page. Please check regularly.
- Please remember to collect medication from Miss Ibbotson before you leave for home!
