Science - Plants

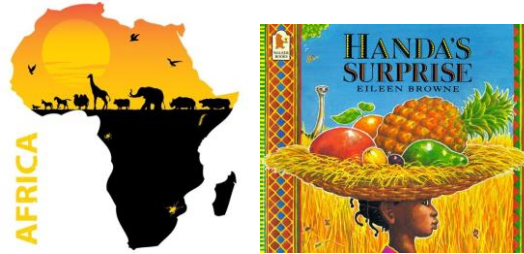
The children will look at the different types of plants and trees in our local area, grow their own sunflowers and look at what a plant needs to grow and survive by carrying out their own investigations.
