Fractions

Identify the following fractions:

$\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$

Find fractions of numbers and shapes.

Measurement - Length and height

To accurately measure using the most appropriate unit (e.g. cm/m)

Measurement - Time

Compare and sequence our daily routine.

Tell the time (up to five minute intervals).

Science - Living things and their habitats.

Children will be learning about the characteristics of a living thing, how different plants and animals adapt to their habitats and the importance of the food chain to stay alive.

Topic - Skipton, Saltaire and Salts Mill

We will look at the geography of our local area and use maps to identify where we are in relation to regional and global landmarks.

We will also look at the history of the area and the industrialisation in the 1800's. We will learn about Sir Titus Salt, the creation of Saltaire and Salts Mill and life for people working in the mills.

PE - Athletics and Yoga

We will develop basic skills (including running, jumping and throwing) through athletics.

We will use yoga and mindfulness to learn how to look after our mental well-being.

PSHCE - Children will learn about citizenship and how we can make our world a better place. We will also learn about how to make decisions by gathering and looking at all the evidence.

Art - Linking to our History topic, we will learn about local artist, David Hockney and recreate some of his artwork using techniques used in his own artwork.

ICT - Children will be using a computer to create music. They will listen to a variety of pieces of music and consider how music can make them think and feel. They will compare creating music digitally and non-digitally.

Curriculum Enrichment -
